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SERIES ESSENCE

On the surface, Healer is a tense psychological thriller set on Suomenlinna island, one of Finland's most cinematic locations. But at its core, it is a story about guilt, grief and the dangerous need to believe.

Emma, a surgeon broken by one fatal mistake, finds refuge in a wellness community that seems to offer exactly what science cannot: absolution. But the closer she gets to the community's leader Roosa, the more the line blurs between healing, manipulation and control.

The result is a contemporary, emotionally charged series about the seduction of certainty, and the price of surrendering your judgement to someone else.

SERIES OVERVIEW

Surgeon Emma moves with her family to the idyllic fortress island of Suomenlinna, hoping to escape the public fallout of a medical error that destroyed her career and left a pregnant patient dead. The island promises peace: a beautiful home, a fresh start, and distance from the threats that have followed her family.

Emma and her teenage daughter soon fall under the spell of Roosa, a charismatic wellness guru whose yoga collective offers comfort, microdosed psychedelics and a seductive new language of healing. When Emma begins to believe her touch can actually cure people, she is pulled further into Roosa's world — and away from the scientific certainty that once defined her.



Then Iiro arrives on the island: the husband of Emma's dead patient, the man who once threatened revenge. Roosa insists his presence is fate and that Emma has the power to help him heal.

But as rituals intensify, boundaries collapse and the island community turns against itself, Emma can no longer tell whether danger is coming from Iiro, from the long-term islanders — or from the woman she has trusted most.

When a body is found in the sea, the question shifts from who needs healing to who is capable of murder.

Faith becomes fear.

Episode Synopsis



EPISODE 1:

You Can't Take Everything Away

Emma moves with her family to Suomenlinna to escape the tragedy that destroyed her career and put her life in danger. Roosa, a young wellness influencer, promises she can help. Emma and her daughter Vieno begin attending yoga classes and secret sessions involving psychedelic microdoses. A new beginning seems possible — until Iiro, the husband of Emma's deceased patient, appears on the course.

EPISODE 2:

It Has Found Me

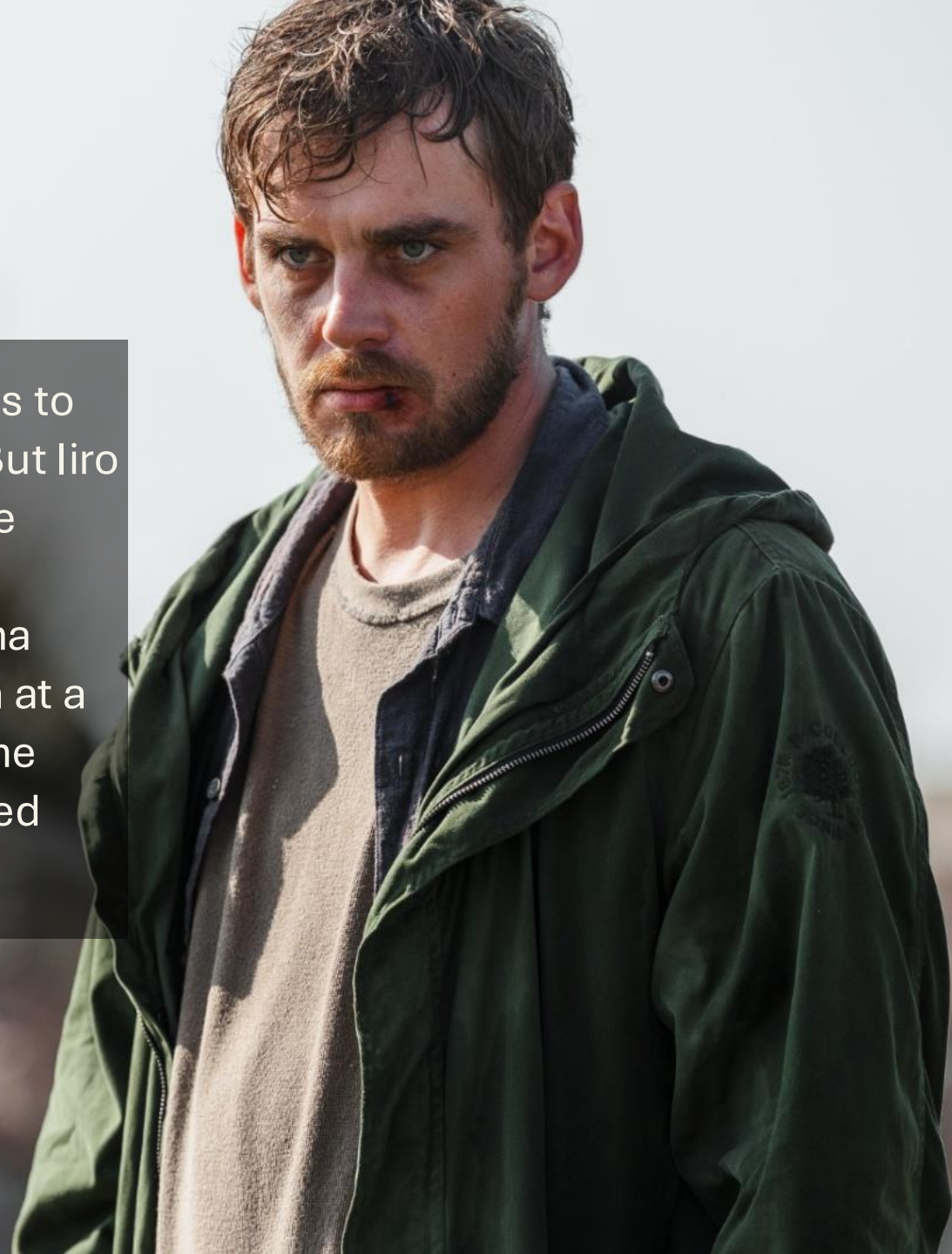
Emma fears Iiro has come for revenge, but he claims he only wants peace. Roosa frames the encounter as a chance for healing and encourages Emma to trust the process. When Emma appears to heal Roosa through touch, Roosa suggests she may have powers that could give her a new purpose. Iiro asks Emma to scatter his wife's ashes, but the ceremony raises new suspicions.



EPISODE 3:

We Belong Together

Emma grows closer to Roosa and begins to explore her apparent healing abilities. But Iiro has not left the island: he is hiding in the fortress tunnels and becoming more delusional, convinced that he and Emma belong together. A violent confrontation at a sauna ritual ends with Iiro fleeing into the water. The next morning, a body is carried from the shore.



EPISODE 4:

Never Apologize for Your Feelings

liro's death is treated as suicide, but police questioning unsettles everyone. Emma suspects Johannes and Eelis are hiding the truth. As guilt fractures Roosa's circle, Emma and Roosa cross an intimate line witnessed by Eelis. When Emma follows the trail toward the real killer, Eelis lures her onto his boat — and Emma must save herself.

EPISODE 5:

Where Are Your Boundaries?

After surviving Eelis, Emma decides to repair her marriage and return to medicine. Roosa has other plans: she has placed Emma at the centre of an upcoming wellness festival. As Emma tries to break away, Roosa reveals a devastating detail from the night Iiro died, making Emma fear that her own daughter may be the murderer.

EPISODE 6:

You're the Killer

Desperate to recover her missing memories, Emma takes LSD and agrees to perform at Roosa's festival to protect Vieno. On stage, a flashback reveals the truth: the woman fleeing the scene was not Vieno, but Roosa. Emma realizes her healing powers were manipulated, her family was used, and Roosa killed Iiro to keep her. Their final confrontation in the sea forces Emma to choose who she really is.



Central Characters

Emma

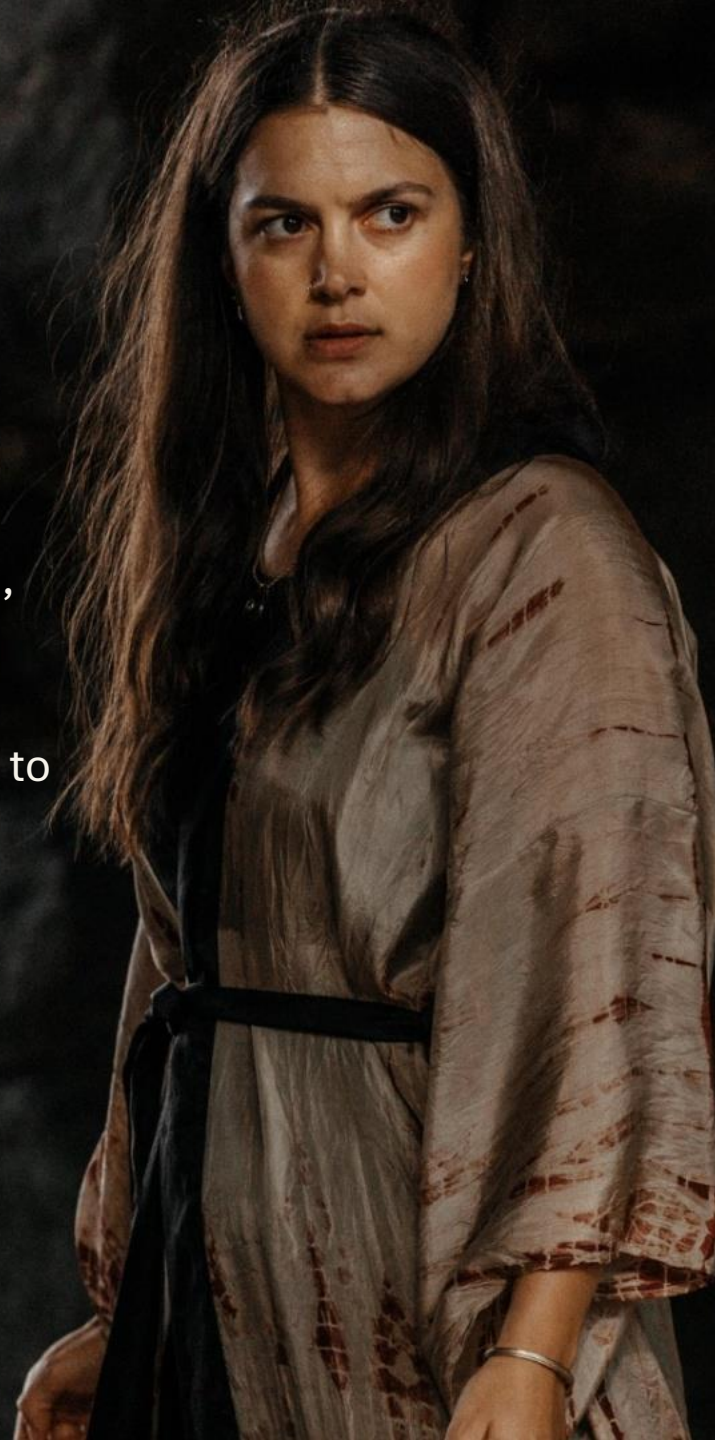

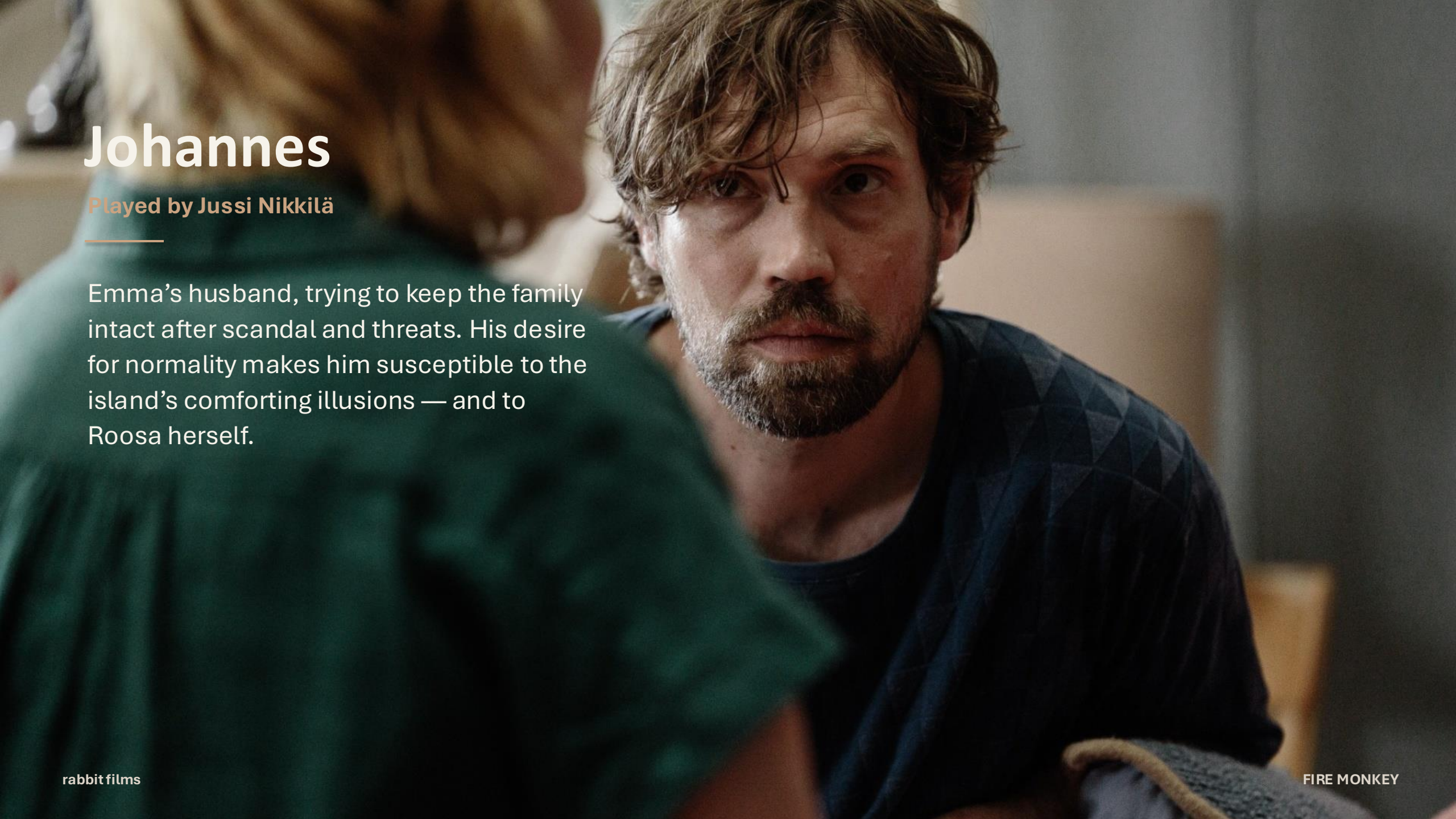
A surgeon whose career and identity have collapsed after a fatal error. Emma comes to Suomenlinna seeking safety, but her grief and guilt make her vulnerable to Roosa's promise of a new kind of healing.

Roosa

Played by Mimosa Willamo

A charismatic wellness guru and leader of a yoga collective. Warm, magnetic and seemingly enlightened, Roosa understands exactly what broken people need to hear — and how to make them dependent on her.





Johannes

Played by Jussi Nikkilä

Emma's husband, trying to keep the family intact after scandal and threats. His desire for normality makes him susceptible to the island's comforting illusions — and to Roosa herself.

liro

Played by Lauri Tilkanen

The grieving husband of Emma's dead patient. He arrives claiming to seek peace, but his presence reopens the family's trauma and turns the island into a theatre of suspicion.

Eelis

Played by Petteri Summanen

A long-term islander and maintenance manager who sees Roosa's collective as an invading force. Protective, suspicious and increasingly volatile, he becomes a dangerous catalyst.

Vieno

Played by Stella Leppikorpi

Emma's teenage daughter, searching for belonging after the family's public trauma. Roosa's world gives her answers, community and power — but also pulls her away from her parents.
